And it [D] breaks her heart to [F#m] think her love is [G] only [G]




Given [Em] to a man with [G] hands as cold as [D] ice. [G // ] [A // ]

She [D] drives on through the [F#m] night anticip-[G]-ating [G]



Cos he [Em] makes her feel the [G] way she used to [D] feel [G // ] [A // ]
